

WHAT'S ON OFFER?

Introductory **kayaking** and canoeing take place on our own lake. The group can also work as a team to design and build a **raft** and take part in the famous 'round the island' races.

A purpose built climbing tower allows your group to experience climbing and abseiling. The Sky Tower with its extra height and advanced features offers further progression. The high ropes challenge and 60m metre zip wire complete the exciting range of activities.


One of our most popular activities is the **Assault course.** All manner of activities such as bridges, crawls, tunnels, swings and nets and plenty of mud must be overcome before you can earn your stripes. A must for groups of all ages.



Archery is another popular activity and sessions are led by our qualified instructors. It can be tried by all ages and abilities and is perfect for family events and groups with a broad age range. Indoor and outdoor facilities are available allowing sessions to take place whatever the weather.

A comprehensive range of **Team Building challenges** completes a wide range of activities on site. **The Great Wall, Swing Thing, The Bomb, Giant's Fingers and Ski Planks** are just a few of the 30 challenging and engaging activities designed to enhance team work and communication skills.

An adjacent private **woodland** provides the ideal location for **orienteering**, **bivouacs**, **wilderness skills and forest adventures**.





Our local beach, Cei Bach, is just a mile from the centre. It is an ideal location for rock pooling, coastal walks and more advanced watersports.

A mile further along the coast lies the pretty coastal village of New Quay. This is where groups can go **sailing** in a beautiful sheltered bay.

In between activity sessions we have a **swimming pool, games field** and **basketball court** to use up any spare energy your group may have.

Evening activities are provided and include a beach visit, the Llain miniolympics, games, our very **groovy disco, campfire with singing**, stories and marshmallow toasting.

CAMPING FOR SCOUTS, GUIDES AND YOUTH CROUPS

Groups from all over the UK and Ireland visit us regularly and the combination of good facilities, high quality activities & a beautiful location means that return visits seem to be the norm. Our camping field comfortably accommodates groups of 30 with all the usual amenities. Adjacent to the camp is a basketball court & swimming pool. Groups can participate in daily activities, we typically provide three activities in a day in activity groups of 10-12. For the above groups we can offer special camping and activity rates. ACCOMMODATION

There are two types of accommodation:

CHALETS – six in all sleeping eight people per chalet. All have living space, shower room and 2 bedrooms sleeping 4 people per room in bunk beds. Total number of beds 48

LODGE – consisting of 5 rooms sleeping up to 40 people in bunk beds. A modern shower block is located adjacent to the Lodge.

GROUP LEADERS – Group leaders are accommodated in their own chalets or mobile homes next to their group's accommodation. All leaders have their own shower rooms, living areas, sleeping accommodation as well as refreshment facilities.

All clients are required to bring their own sleeping bags or bedding with a pillowcase. (Bedding is provided for group leaders).

The Wales Tourist Board awarded the centre 2 stars for its accommodation.

FOOD

Food is provided on a full board basis from the evening meal on the day of arrival to a packed lunch on the day of departure. With notice all special dietary requirements can be catered for.

We understand that healthy appetites develop from lots of fresh air and exercise. We have rave reviews about the catering side of the centre. Fresh Homemade Pizza, Roast Welsh Lamb, the best Chilli in the West and some very lovely Curries are just a few of our specialities.
